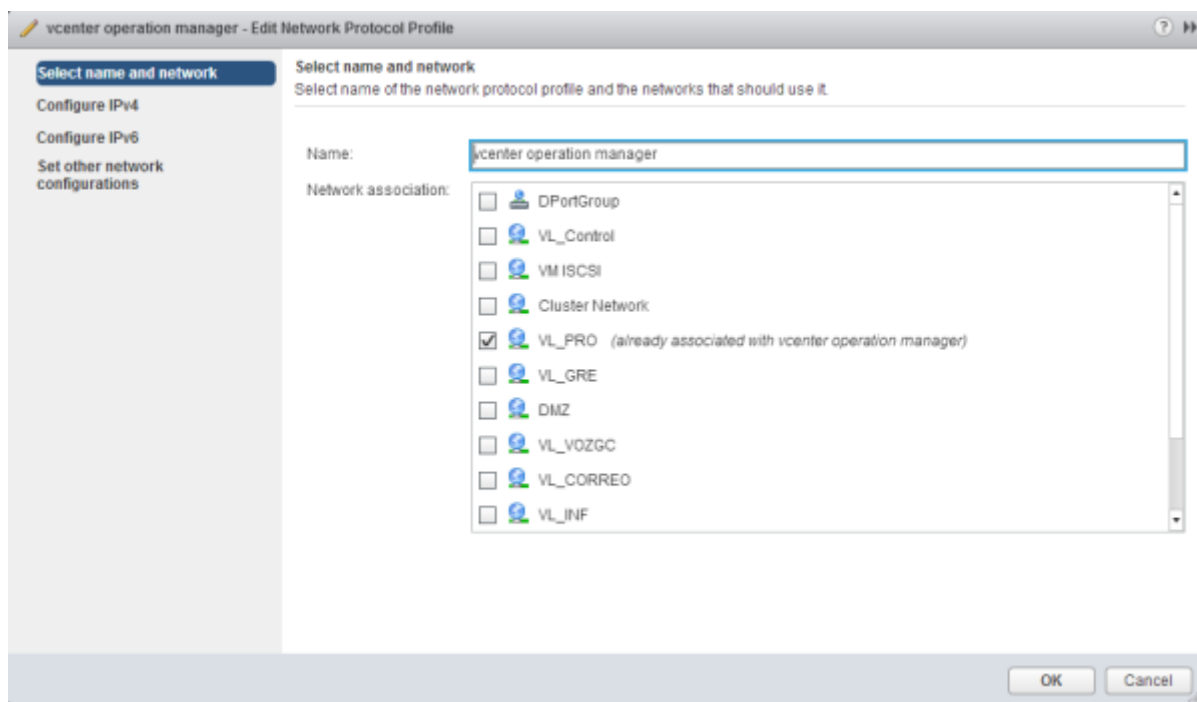
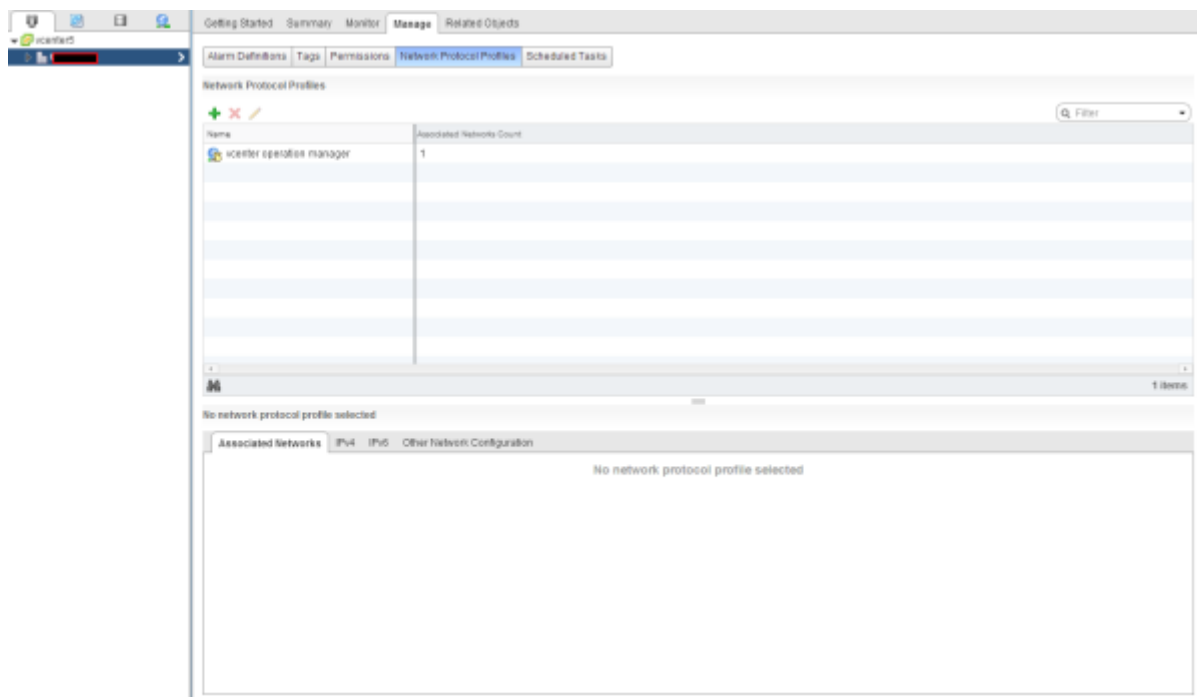


Vcenter Operation Manager
