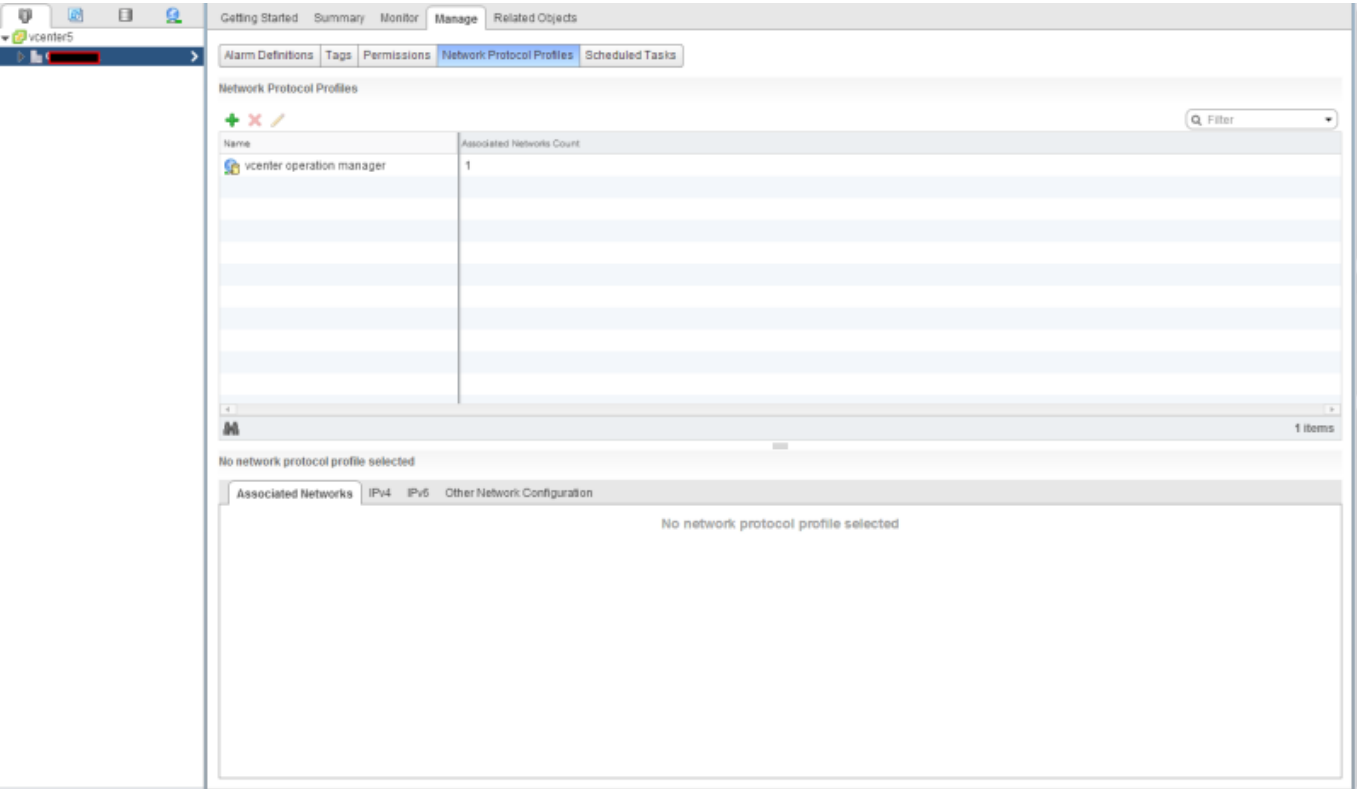


Vcenter Operation Manager
